Should a student leave Mercy for any reason during the school year, parents/guardians are responsible for tuition according to the following schedule:

## FINANCIAL AID OFFERINGS 2022-2023

Mercy Academy continually seeks new resources to provide increased financial aid and scholarships. Nearly \$1 million will be available for need and merit-based grants and scholarships in 2022-23. We encourage families to apply for financial aid by following the steps outlined below:

- Mercy provides a link to the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment application for all school families and all 8<sup>th</sup> graders who took the placement test at Mercy.
- Create a FACTS account, fill out the entire questionnaire, and pay the \$30 application fee. Upload a PDF file that includes prior year tax return, all W-2's and any supporting documentation that is required.
- Financial aid applications are due by January 30 for priority consideration and families will receive an email notification from Mercy in late April letting them know their financial aid award status.
- Financial aid applications received after January 30 will be reviewed as funding allows.

**Returning families:** Your student must be registered for the fall semester, including payment of registration fee and current on tuition for 2021-22 in order to receive financial aid notification from the school.

# **GRANT AND SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

#### Need-Based Aid:

This pool of money is made up of funds from Mercy Academy, the Archdiocese of Louisville and donations from Mercy community.

### Mercy Day Scholarships:

Memorial and corporate scholarships are awarded each year for academics, service and community leadership. These are applied for in the spring, awarded in late April and the funds will reduce your tuition for the following school year. Students must demonstrate financial need; therefore, all scholarship applicants must also apply for financial aid.

#### Merit-Based Scholarships:

Mercy offers a tiered academic scholarship for those who score highly on the high school placement test: 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$3,000 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$2,500 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$2,000 All students in the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile: \$1,000

\*These scholarships are renewable all four years for students who remain in good academic standing.

#### Sisters' Discount:

Families with more than one student attending Mercy at the same time will receive \$2,000 off the oldest student's tuition.
